Biology of cell destruction: active roles of cell death in development and organismal homeostasis



Masayuki Miura is Professor of Department of Genetics, Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, The University of Tokyo. His research interest is to reveal the physiological roles and basic mechanisms of cell death in development, regeneration and tissue homeostasis. He is Chair, the Board of Directors, The Japanese Society for Cell Death Research.
